- 1. Present were: Geoff, Hilary, Sally, Penny (not quorate)
- 2. September minutes and matters arising no formal minutes were produced
- 3. Project updates:
- a) Green Coffee this had taken place but no attendees present at the meeting
- b) Incredible Edible and Seed Library The bake-off event had been a success. An update appears in the recent newsletter.
- c) Pomarium and Forest Garden Hilary reported an urgent need for more volunteers to maintain these. There was discussion about how the numbers could be increased. There could be a poster appealing for volunteers laminated and put up in situ at the Pomarium on the notice board. The Wassail event could be publicised early to get people interested. Sally could contact the Blackthorn Trust which might be a help. Hilary does need help in organising events.
 PN had been in touch with Tir Coed earlier in the summer. They were uncertain about their continued funding but said they had arranged with Dorienne for a green furniture course to take place at the Forest Garden. Hilary not aware of this. PN to contact them again to follow up The acorns are very plentiful this year. It would be good to have an event around preparing them as a food source, however this would require someone to organise and run it...

 Hilary reported how the International Repair Day had been celebrated with cake and posters. It had been a good day. A permanent home for the Repair Café is being sought as Celf o Gwmpas does not have space for all the tools. The Hive has now been taken over by the Town Council and all the tools have had to be moved to Ashfields, who have kindly offered to house them for free at present. Hilary is looking at researching potential permanent homes for the Repair Cafe following the removal of equipment to Ashfield.

Sian has continued making Morsbags at home and they are given out at the Repair Café. Sian was going to ask Lucy about labels for TLT to put on the bags – still pending.

It is therefore very important to these projects that this trust thrives. Penny suggested that Lee and Jenny Percy at the Chalybeate Café in the Rock Park be approached, a) to put up a poster appealing for trustees in the café and b) to see if they would consider being trustees themselves, as they are very involved. Hilary will talk to David about posters and speak to the café.
